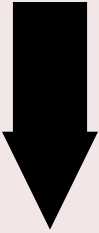

**Bill Snyder Family Stadium Plan**

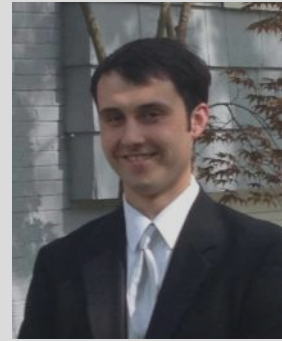

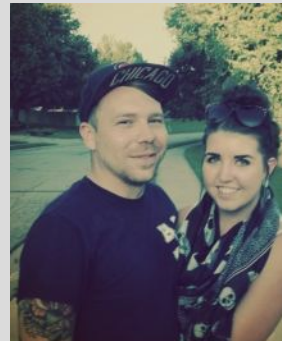

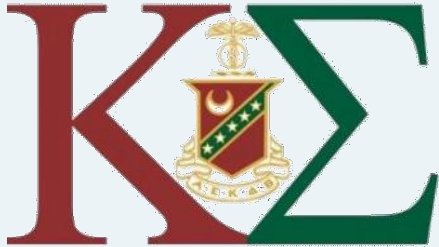
